

## 2024 STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING FELLOWSHIP

The Structural Engineering Fellowship was created in 1998 to support research that has the potential to influence how structures can positively impact our built environment. The \$20,000 Structural Engineering Fellowship is awarded annually to a graduating student based in the United States who specializes in structural engineering to conduct independent travel and research that contributes to the SOM Foundation's current topic. This year's topic is "Adapting Housing Strategies to Respond to New Realities."

Proposals are evaluated by an independent jury of professionals that changes each year, representing a diversity of perspectives and expert knowledge in the topic area. Fellows thoroughly document their research findings and develops conclusions or suggestions for applications to teaching and/ or professional practice.
