



## 2024 Jim McGee Memorial Scholarship General Academic Scholarship Information

The scholarships under this program are available for those students seeking a career in civil engineering, civil engineering technology, or other transportation or construction related fields.

### Amount

The highest scoring applicant will receive the maximum award of **\$2000**.

Based on the application review committee's recommendations, up to two additional scholarships may be awarded to either:

- 1) The first runner-up (**\$2000**), or
- 2) Split (**\$1000** each) between the first and second runners-up.

### Eligibility

1. The applicant must be enrolled in an ABET accredited program at a school in Georgia.
2. The applicant must be an undergraduate who will be entering either the third or fourth year of a four-year program or the second year of a two-year program by the fall semester of the submission year. The applicant must be enrolled as a full-time student for the fall semester of the submission year (Fall 2024).
3. The applicant is eligible to receive the award only once.
4. The applicant must submit a completed application and a copy of their college transcript. Resumes may also be included but are not required.
